

## Off-Road Vehicles on Town of Kirkland Lake Streets

There is a new by-law for regulating what type of off-road vehicles are permitted on Town streets. Now in addition to all-terrain vehicles, there can be multi-purpose off-highway utility vehicles and recreational off-highway vehicles. Full definition of these vehicles can be found in [Ontario Regulation 316/03](#). Here is a quick visual to help guide what is permitted and what is not:

### These are Permitted

Common ORV Types	All Terrain Vehicles (ATVs)		Side-by-Sides	
	 "single-rider" all-terrain vehicle (ATV)	 two-up all-terrain vehicle (two-up ATV)	 recreational off-highway vehicle (ROV)	 utility terrain vehicle (UTV)

### These are NOT

 off-road motorcycle (ORM)	 extreme terrain vehicle (XTV)

It is also important to note that the new by-law has changed the language for use of portions of Government Road. Off-road vehicles are **no longer permitted on any part of Government Road** as this was not supported by the MTO. Users may cross over Government Road but may not drive along it.
