NOTICE OF THE VOTERS' LIST

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the list of all persons entitled to be electors for municipal elections in this municipality has been prepared by the Municipal Clerk's office.

Effective Thursday, September 1, 2022, all electors should ensure that their names and relevant information are correct on the Voters' List. This is encouraged prior to attending any poll to avoid delays.

A person may make an application to the Municipal Clerk requesting that their name be added to or removed from the Voters' List or that information on the Voters' List relating to them be amended by completing and filing the prescribed form available at: **Office of the Municipal Clerk, Town of Kirkland Lake, 3 Kirkland Street West (Town Hall), Kirkland Lake ON P2N 3P4**, during regular office hours between September 1, 2022 to October 21, 2022 and to the close of voting on October 24, 2022. The application shall be in writing and shall be filed in person, or by mail or email by the applicant or his/her agent. The applicant's proof of identity and residence as prescribed in *O. Reg. 304/13* will be required. If the applicant does not appear in person, a certified copy showing proof of ID and proof of residence/occupancy is required.

QUALIFICATIONS OF ELECTORS

A person is entitled to vote in a municipal election if he or she or they on voting day,

- resides in the local municipality, or is the owner or tenant of land in the municipality, or the spouse of such owner or tenant; and
- is a Canadian citizen, and
- is at least 18 years old, and
- is not prohibited from voting by law.
